Governments are pleased to issue the following as a ruling under note (3) to clause (7) of rule 12 Part I K.S.R.

Ruling

In all cases of deputation of officers for a course of instruction or training under these rules, the period of such training if treated as duty under sub-clause (iii) of the above Rule, should be specified as such, in the orders sanctioning such deputation. A separate clause that the period will count for increment, leave and pension is not necessary in such cases. In case where on Officer selected for training is found unsuitable on medical examination or otherwise, the period spent by him in India for journey for Medical examination, etc, in connection with the training will be treated as leave and no Traveling allowance will be allowed for such journeys.
