**ORDER**

In the G.O third cited regarding equation of posts in the Forest Department it was inter alia ordered that the Foresters in Malabar area and the Deputy rangers and Foresters in Travancore- Cochin area would be kept separate and that the question of integrating them or not would be examined separately by the Administrative Department. The Dy. Rangers and foresters of the T.C. branch are borne on a State-wise basis and promotion to the category of Rangers is effected from dy.Rangers, Grade I. In the absence of an inetermediate category of Dy Rangers in Madras, promotion to the category of Rangers borne on a State-Wise basis is made from the category of Forest who is borne on a District-Wise basis. The question of filling up the posts od Rangers in Kerala on or after 1-11-1956 was considered by Government and it was ordered in the G.O. read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper that promotion to the posts of Rangers would be effected from the combined gradatrion list of the Dy. Rangers and foresters of T.C. and of the Foresters of Malabar. Government now order that the Posts of Dy. Rangers, grade I on Rs. 80-150, Grade II Rs.40-120 and of Foresters on Rs. 40-80 of Travancore Cochin will be clubbed together and equated with the posts of Foresters on Rs.50-85 of Madras and that the inter-state seniorityof persons of eother units on 1-1-1956 will be determined on the basis of the length of continuous service in the equated categories.

2. Government approves the enclosed preliminary integrated gradation list of the Deputy Rangers and foresters of Travancore- Cochin and of the Foresters of Madras

of the forest Department as on 1-1-1956 prepared in accordance with the G.Os. Cited and the orders contained in Para 1 above

3. The Superintendent of government Presses will arrange to public the list in the next issue of the Gazette and to supply 350 copies of the list to the chief Conservator of forests, a dozen copies each to the agriculture (Forest) Department and the Public (Integration special) Department and 50 copies to the Public (Integration ) Department

4. The Chief Conservator of forests is requested to circulate the list among the officers concerned inviting appeals if any be presented within a period of one month from the date publication of the list in the Gazette. He is also requested forward such appeals to the Public (Integration) department with his specific remarks in each case
