## ORDER

In the G.O read above, it was ordered that no officer of Government should be given re-appointment, extension of service or re-Employment beyond the age of compulsory retirement in Government service. At present there is no similar specific ban use re-employment of Retired government servants by Public sector institutions. The question of banning such re-employment has been engaging the attention of the Government for some time past.

2. After examining the matter in detail, the Government order that all Public sector institutions under the control of the State Government should not hereafter re-employ any person who has retired from the service of the Central Government or any State Government .these institution should not also extend the period of appointment of such retired personnel at present in their employment without the prior permission of the Government. For purposes of this order public Sector institutions been any Company in which not less than 51 % of the paid-up share capital in hold by this Government including all statutory cooperating and Boards constituted by the State Government.
