S.R.O.NO. 95/- In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 36, 40 and 76 of the Kerala Forest Act, 1961 (4of 1962), the Government to Kerala hereby under the following rules further to amend the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1975, issued under notification G.O.(P) No.346/75/AD Dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1976 and published on S.R.O. No.76/76 in the Kerala Gazette No.3 dated the 20<sup>th</sup> January, 1976.

## RULES

Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Forest Produce Transit (Amendment) Rules 1995. (2) They shall be come into force at once.

- 2. Amendment of the Rules. In the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1975.
  - (1) In rule 4, in the 1<sup>st</sup> proviso to clause (a) of sub rule (4), for the words "cardamom Nadwarukku the words symbol and brackets "Cardamom, Vatta/Upputhi (Macarangnpoltata) and Murukku shall be substituted.
  - (2) <u>In rule 12</u>.
    - (i) in sub-rule (i) for the sentences" The registration shall be in force until the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, following such registration or renewal. A property mark registered or renewed under this rule shall be different for each Depot "the sentences". The registration shall he in force for a period of five years counting from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April of the year of registration. A property mark registered or renewed under this rule shall be different for each Depot." Shall be substituted.
    - (ii) for sub-rule (3) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-
  - "(2) The fees for registration or renewal of property mark or a period of five years or part thereof shall be Rupees Two Thousand & Fire hundred".
