**C I R C U L A R**

Sub:- Credit sale of handloom cloth – ban orders to be issued to drawing officers to approve to recovery from the pay of State/Public Sector employees against request from institution other than HANTEX and HANVEEV.

The monopoly on the implementation of the scheme of credit sale of handloom cloth to Government Servants and employees of the Public Sector Undertakings are restricted to the HANTEX and HANVEEV. As part of the implementation of the scheme the responsibility to recover the amount due to the credit sale has also been fixed upon the drawing and disbursing officers of the Govt. Depts and the Chief Executives of the Public Sector Undertakings. But it has come to the notice of the Government that some drawing and disbursing officers of Government Depts. And the Chief Executives of the Public Sector Undertakings have undertaken the responsibility to recover the amounts towards the cost of credit sales run by the Co-optex and other private traders. This will definitely defeat the very intension of Government in regard to the sales promotion of handloom cloths produced within the State. Therefore all drawing and disbursing Officers and the Chief Executives of Public Sector Undertakings are instructed not to take the responsibility to recover on behalf of the Co-optex and other parallel, private traders.

Any violation of their instructions will be viewed seriously.
