Sub.- Public Services- Provisional (temporary) appointments- Continuance beyond three months -Further Clarifications issued.

Ref. -Government Circular No. 45283/SDI /81/GAD dated 6-7-1981.

In the Circular cited all Heads of Departments and other appointing authorities were requested that the provisional (temporary) employees who were then in service and who will be completing three months should not be relived but may be allowed to continue in service till 180 days , as Government are considering g the question of extending the time limit for provisional appointments from 3 months to 180 days.

2. The above instructions are intended to be applicable to all provisional (temporary) employees who were in service on 6-7-1981 and who were recruited after that date. Government therefore wish to clarify that provisional (temporary) appointments made by direct recruitment on or after 6-7-1981 under the provisions of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services rules, may also be allowed to continue up to 180 days, instead of three months as provided in the existing rule.
