ORDER

In the G.O. read above Government inter-alia modified the procedure prescribed for providing employment assistance to Relatives/ Dependents of Government Servants dying in harness by reducing the minimum period of Service to be put in by an employee so as to render his dependents eligible for appointment under the dying in harness scheme from 10 years to 5 years.

2. Government are now pleased to order that the reduced minimum period of 5 years will have retrospective effect from 16-1-1979.
