## **ORDER**

Government have under Article 227 T.S.R. provided for the grant of Compassionate Gratuity to the families of Government servants dying before retirement or within one year from the date of retirement. While reporting the death by committing suicide on 9-5-1955 of one Sri Raghavan, Excise Guard No. 437, the Secretary, Board of Revenue, has raised the question whether the benefits contemplated under Article 227 T.S.R. could be extended to the family of a Government servant who commits suicide.

Having considered the question with reference to the background in which Article 227 T.S.R. was introduced, Government are pleased to order that Compassionate Gratuity will be granted in cases of suicides also if they are otherwise eligible for the same under the rules. Compassionate Gratuity is intended to benefit the family of a deceased is no consideration in this matter.
