NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules namely-

AMENDMENT

C.S. No.15/61 dated 16-6-1961

In Part II of the said Rules in rule 47, the following shall be added as Notes (1) and (2) namely:-

“Note (1) The Heads of Departments are empowered to sanction journeys of subordinate officers to the adjoining districts of neighbouring States.

“Note (2) The Heads of Departments and District Collectors will be competent to undertake journeys outside the State in the adjoining districts of neighbouring States in public interests.

(This amendment shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1-11-1959)”.
