## ORDER

In the Government Order cited as first paper, orders were issued allowing the District Collector, Alleppey and Tahsildars of Changannur and Thiruvalla, to claim mileage for their journeys to and from Alleppey via Mavelikkara in relaxation of Rule 13(b) K.S.R. Part II in view of the fact that the Alleppey – Changannur route is not travel worthy particularly during rainy season. In the Government Order second cited, the concession granted as per the G.O. cited as first paper above was extended to all touring officers of the State till the Alleppey – Changanacherry read becomes travel worthy. In para 4 of the G.O dated 24-10-1960 the Chief Engineer (Buildings and Roads) fit for travel by motor vehicles.

- 2. In his letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above the Chief Engineer (B & R) has reported that the Alleppey Changanacherry read is travel –worthy and that it is used by all vehicles.
- 3. In view of the above report of the Chief Engineer (B&E), Government feel that the concession referred to in para (1) is not more necessary, and they accordingly order, that the orders cited as first and second paper, will stand cancelled with effect from 1-4-1961.
