- (i) To rule 120 the following words shall be added at the end namely:-
  - "His pension for service in the Civil Department shall not be affected by his military pension ".
- In rule 122, for the words and figures "Except as provided in (ii) rule 121" the following words and figures shall be substituted, namely:-

"Except as provided in rules 120 and 121".

This notification shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from 1st November, 1956.
