NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the Powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendments to the Kerala Service Rules, namely :-

AMENDMENTS

C.S. No. 28/62.

Dated 5th October 1962,

In Part III of the said rules, -

1, after rule 73, the following shall be inserted as rule 73 A, namely :-
“ Rule 73 A – Notwithstanding anything in rules 73, in the case of Drivers and Vehicle Examiners of the State Transport Department, the amount of gratuity, superannuation, invalid, compensation and retiring pension will be the appropriate amount set out in the following table. The concession as contemplated in this rule will be applicable to Drivers who are directly recruited as such and to Vehicle Examiners promoted as such from the category of Drivers referred to above.”

2. After rule 76, the following shall be inserted as a proviso, namely :-
 “Provided, however, that for the purpose of calculation of D.C.R. Gratuity in the case of Drivers and Vehicle Examiners coming under rule 73 A who have a qualifying service of 15 years and more the numeratory of the fraction adopted for calculating the pension of the Officer will be taken as the number of completed years of service, and in cases where the qualifying service is 5 years or more but less than 15 years the calculation will be made on the basis of actual number of years of qualifying service rendered by the Officer”.
3. In rule 88, the existing Note shall be numbered as Note (1) and the following shall be inserted as Note (2) namely :-
 “Note (2) In the case of Drivers and Vehicle Examiners of the State Transport Department whose cases are governed by rule 73 A, 16 years qualifying service will be deemed to be sufficient

This amendment shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st November, 1956.
