ELECTION-GENERAL ELECTION TO THE STATE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY 1965-PRESENTATION AND SETTLEMENT OF FINAL T.A. CLAIMS DURING MARCH 1965-SANCTION ACCORDED.

ORDER

The procedure for the drawal of final T.A bills for election duty in connection with the ensuing general elections has been prescribed in the G.O. read above.

- (2) The date of poll in connection with the ensuing General Election has now been fixed as 4th March, 1965. It is necessary that all claims relating to T.A. in connection with the general elections are settled and all advances towards T.A and D.A drawn by the various officers in connection with the election are adjusted in full during the financial year 1964-65 itself as the provision for the expenditure has been made in the budget for 1965-65. Government thereof direct, in relaxation of the rules, that all final claims relating to T.A, D.A etc., for polling and counting duties in connection with the ensuing general election will be allowed to be drawn and presented to the District Collectors for countersignature immediately after the date of poll or counting, and payments or adjustments will be allowed to be made in the month of March 1965 itself. Al drawing officers and gazetted officers will prepare and present the claims towards T.A. and D.A for election duties to the District Collectors with the necessary certificates and other documents for countersignature immediately after the day of poll or counting so as to enable them to return the bills to the drawing officers after scrutiny and countersignature sufficiently early for encashment or adjustment in March 1965 itself.
- (3) To ensure the expeditious and prompt settlement of T.A claims relating to the ensuing general elections, all drawing officers and gazetted officers are also requested to record a certificate in the Pay/Salary bills for April 1965 presented by them for encashment in May 1965 to the effect that the final T.A bills for election duty in connection with the general elections of 1965 have been presented for countersignature and no further claim is due from them, or that that or the persons for whom they are the drawing officers, have not been selected for election duty. The Treasury Officers will not pass for encashment the pay/Salary bills for the drawing officers or gazetted officers for 1965 without the above certificate. The Heads of Departments will issue necessary instructions to their subordinates in the matter.
