ORDER

Expenditure on account of the payment of gratuity in lieu of notice on abolition of an appointment under rule 47 Part III K.S.Rs. Is charged to “65-Superannuation allowances etc.” In the letter read as first paper, the Account General has pointed out that as per the decision of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, the expenditure on account of the payment of such gratuity is to be charged to the particular department to which the pay of the appointment was debited before its abolition and has suggested that this classification may be adopted in the State. The Government accept the suggestion of the Accountant General; and are pleased to incorporate the following as a Government decision under rule 47 Part III K.S.Rs.

Government Decision No 7/65

“The gratuity paid in lieu of notice on abolition of an appointment should be charged to the particular department to which the pay of the appointment was debited before its abolition”.
