Rule 116, Kerala Service Rules Part II, contains instructions regarding the scrutiny of T.A Bills by the controlling officers, with a view to ensure that the claims preferred are in accordance with rules and that irregular claims are disallowed. But in his letter read above, the Accountant General has brought to the notice of Government that most of the fundamental checks required to be exercised in the scrutiny of T. A Bills are not being exercised by the controlling officers and has pointed out that the responsibility for ensuring that the claims are justified is one to be shared by the controlling officer and the Audit Office.

2. Government consider that strict scrutiny of the T.A bills is necessary and direct that the controlling officers should be vigilant in exercising the checks expected of them when signing or countersigning the T.A Bills. Non compliance by the Controlling Officers with the requirements of Rule 116 K.S.R. Part II will be viewed seriously by Government.
