But are summoned to give evidence in a departmental enquiry-
Rates of traveling allowance admissible.

In continuation of the Government Memorandum cited, extract of rule 387 of the Criminal Rules of Practice and Orders, Madras as amended in G.O.(MS) No.164/66/Home dated 27-4-1966, is furnished below for general information and guidance of all concerned. The rules now applicable on the Malabar are the Madras Rules.

“387 Traveling allowance of non-official witnesses:-

Subject to the provisions of Rule 384-a and Rule 384-B the following are the maximum rates of allowances which may be sanctioned to the different classes of non-official witnesses and no expenses in excess of , or other than, these prescribed herein shall be allowed. The Judge or Magistrate shall fix the class of persons who are required to appear before him either as witnesses or complaints with due regard to the station in life they occupy”.
