ORDER

In the Government Order read as first paper, it was ordered as an exception in Rule 54, Part II, Kerala Service Rules, that an officer in receipt of Permanent Travelling allowance when deputed for training outside the State, may claim Daily Allowance for halts in lieu of Permanent Travelling Allowance subject to the provisions of Rules. In his letter read as third paper, the District Collector, Ernakulam, has requested that the above benefit may be extended also to those officers who are deputed for training at a station within the State but outside the area of jurisdiction. In the Government Order read as second paper exchange of Permanent Travelling allowance of Daily Allowance has been allowed also in cases where the officers in receipt of Permanent Travelling Allowance have to halt outside their area of jurisdiction for the performance of official duties.

After examining all the aspects of the question, Government are pleased to order that officers who are in receipt of permanent Travelling allowance and who are deputed for training at an outstation beyond their area of jurisdiction may claim Daily Allowance for halts in lieu of Permanent Travelling allowance subject to the normal rule for the drawal of Daily Advance.

Formal amendment to Kerala Service Rules will issue separately.
