ORDER

Sri M.K.Kunju Panicker, U.D.Clerk, who was working in the Forest Department, retired from service on superannuation on 10.9.1969. He rendered war service for 5 years 8 months, and 22 days from 23.7.1941 to 19.3.1947. He entered in State service on 16.7.1948 in the Factories and Boilers Department and continued their till 11.2.1124 and was subsequently relieved for want of vacancy. He was again appointed as Clerk in the Forest Department from 25.11.1948.

The Accountant General is reported to have observed that since the break between military service and Civil service put in by Sri Kunju Panicker has exceeded one year the same has to be condoned by Government in the light of G.O.(P) 214/69/X PD dated 24.7.1969.

The Government have examined the question in all its aspect and found that the said break of service is not due to any fault of the incumbent. In the circumstances sanction is accorded for the break between the military service and civil service of Sri M.K.Kunju Panicker, retired U.D.Clerk, Forest Department being condoned as a special case.
