## ORDER

According to para (viii) of the Government order read as first paper above, the retirement of Government of Government employees will take effect from the afternoon of the last date of the month in which they attain the age of superannuation. The Director of Technical Education, in his letter read as second paper above has requested clarification as to whether a person whose date of retirement falls on a public holiday has to be relieved on the working day immediately preceding the last day of the month or whether he can be retained in service up to the end of the holidays. After examining the question in all its aspects. Government are pleased to clarify that a retiring officer can relinquish charge on a public holiday if the retirement date falls on a holiday, as there is no ban on handing over charge or assuming charge of an office on public holidays.
