- Sub: Pensioners-Re-employed military Pensioners-Pay and allowances instructions Regarding.
- Ref: 1.Letter No. A./06299/AG/PS 4 (A) 11354/D(Pension/service) DATED 21-10-1964 Of the Government of India.
 - 2. Letter No B3-32614/75-1 dated 27-12-1975 of Director of Vigilance Investigation addressed to Special Secretary to Government, Vigilance Department.

As per the instructions contained in the Government of India letter cited, When military pensioner is re-employed by any of the authorities such as Defence Services, Civil Departments (Central and State), Railways, Reserve **Bank of** India, Local Bodies, Government owned or Government controlled Corporations, Companies, Board, etc, the re-employer should as soon as it comes to his notice that the employees is a military pensioner, inform the Controller Defence Accounts (Pensions) Allahabad of the particulars of the Pensioner.

2. In the letter second cited the Director of Vigilance Investigation as reported to Government that certain cases had come to notice where the above procedure had not been followed by the employers resulting in over payment of temporary/ad hoc increase to the re-employed military pensioners, for which they are not eligible.

3. In order to guard against such over payment all Heads of Departments and Officers including Managing Directors of all Government owned and Government Controlled Corporations, Municipal Commissioners and Panchayat Executive Officers are requested to see that as soon as a military Pensioner is re-employed under them, the details of the pensioner should be made available to the C.D.A, (Allahabad) at the time of appointment itself.
