Sub:- Counting of temporary/officiating service for pension-Recovery of Contributions-Instructions issued.

Ref:- Letter No. PRI/GI/6-44/76-77/340 dated 4-1-1977 and dated 1-3-1977 from the Accountant General, Kerala.

In respect of local fund employees who have opted for Kerala Service Rules no additional pension contribution to cover the extra amount of pension on account of tem0porary/ officiating service reckoned as qualifying service is now being recovered. Government after a review of the practice hitherto followed have decided to insist on the recovery of pension contribution in respect of pure temporary/officiating, service also which counts for pension under the rules in Kerala Service Rules.

The concerned Department Officers are hereby directed to see that additional contribution in respect of local fund employees in service opted for Kerala Service Rules are remitted even for purely temporary/ officiating service which counts for pension @ 1/6 of the average cost of the posts in which employees worked in the fund establishments.
