#### ORDER

In the G.O read as  $3^{rd}$  paper above, Government have ordered that the actual room rent paid by a State Government Officer in private hotel or guest houses in New Delhi, diminished by  $1/3^{rd}$  of the Dearness Allowance admissible, will be reimbursed to him, in case accommodation is not available in the Kerala House, New Delhi, and that this will be subject to a maximum of Rs. 100 per day.

2.Government are now pleased to order that the above rate will apply to Bombay and Calcutta also. Accordingly the actual room rent paid by the State Government Officers, on official tour, in private hotels and guest houses at Bombay and Calcutta will be reimbursed to them subject to their admissible Dearness Allowance being diminished by  $1/3^{rd}$ . This will be subject to a maximum of Rs. 100 per day.
