AMENDMENT-ISSUED

NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No.85/77-In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section2
of the kerala public services act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 there of the
Government of kerala here by make the following amendment to the kerala service rules,
namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S.No.312/77Dated 17th January 1977.

In part III of the said rules, to sub-rule (7) of rule 90 the following proviso shall
be added, namely:-

“Provided that if the son or daughter of a Government employee is suffering from
any disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled so as to render him
or her unable to earn a living even after attaining the age of 18 years in the case of the son
and 21years in the case of the daughter, the family pension shall be payable to such son
or daughter for life subject to the following conditions, namely:-

1. If such son or daughter is one among two or more children of the Government
employee the family pension shall be initially payable to the minor children in
the order set out in sub-rule 8 until the last minor child attains the age of 18 or
21, years as the case may be, and thereafter the family pension shall be
resumed in favor of the on or daughter suffering from disorder or disability of
mind or who is physically crippled or disabled and shall be payable to him/her
for life.

2. If there are more than one such son or daughter suffering disorder or disability of mind or who are physically crippled or disabled, the family pension shall be paid in the following order, namely:-
 - (a) Firstly, to the son, and if there are more than daughter the younger of them will get the family pension only after lifetime of the elder.
 - (b) Secondly to the daughter, and if there are more than one daughter the younger of them will get the family pension only after the life time of the elder.
3. The family pension shall be paid to such son or daughter through the guardian as if he or she were a minor
4. Before allowing the family pension for life to any such son or daughter the sanctioning authority shall satisfied that the handicap is of such a nature as to prevent him or her from earning his or her livelihood and the same shall be evidenced by a certificate obtained from a medical officer not below the rank of a civil surgeon setting out, as for as possible, the exact mental or physical condition of the child;
5. The person receiving the family pension as guardian of such son or daughter shall produce every three years a certificate from a medical other not below the rank of a civil surgeon to the effect that he or she continues to suffer from disorder or disability of mind or continues to be physically crippled or disabled.”

Explanatory Note

The Government of India, have amended Rule 54 (b) of the central Civil Service (Pension) Rule 1972 so as to entitle the sons or daughter of deceased officers, who are suffering from any disorder or disability of mind or physically dripped or disabled so as to render them unable to earn a living even after attaining the age of 18 years in the case of the son and 21 years in the case of the daughter to enjoy family pension of life subject to certain conditions. Government have examined the desirability of adopting the procedure in the case of their employees And are pleased to amend rule 90 of part III, Kerala Service Rule as above.
