#### Explanatory Note

In G.O (P) 535/67/Fin dated 11-12-1967 Government revised the rates of compensatory allowance to be paid to various classes of officers deputed for training outside the State in cases where the period of training exceeds three months. These rates were fixed with due regard to the earlier revision of pay scales and the revision of rates of daily allowance for habits. Since then the scales of pay as well as the rates of daily allowances of Government employees have been revised twice. But corresponding charges have not been made in the rates of compensatory allowance. The classification of officers for the purpose of T.A has also been revised as per G.O. (P) 94/74/Fin dated 24-7-1974. Considering these aspects, Government have decided to revise the existing rate of compensatory allowance suitably. The above notification is meant to achieve the above purpose.
