## **ORDER**

Rules 60-A, Part I, Kerala Service Rules lays down that Government may in Public interest, order an officer to be compulsorily retired at any time after he has attained the age of 43 years. At the time when Rules 60 A Part I Kerala Service Rules was introduced i.e., no provisions was included therein for review of such cases or to take back to service the persons so compulsorily retired. The provision for review was only subsequently introduced by the G.O. read above, But there is no provision in the Kerala Service Rules as to how the period of absence is to be treated in the case of officers compulsorily retired under Rule 60 A Part I Kerala Service Rules and reinstated constantly.

- 2. Government have examined the question and are now pleased to issue the following orders:-
- (1) In the case of officers who have been compulsorily retired under rule 60 A Part, I Kerala Service Rules and subsequently reinstated on review their period of absence and pay and allowances during the period for which they were out of service will be regulated by rule 56 of Part1, Kerala Service Rules.
- (ii) Retirement benefits, if any, already paid to them will be recovered in installments,
