ORDER

In the G.O. read as third paper above it has been ordered that, in the case of officers who have compulsorily retired under rule 60 A Part I Kerala Service Rules and subsequently reinstated on review, their period of absence and pay and allowances during the period for which they were out of service will be regulated by rule 56 Part I of Kerala Service Rules. It has since been examined whether persons so reinstated on review will be eligible for further benefits like promotion also. It is seen that all the officers who were given compulsory retirement under rule 60A Part I Kerala Service Rules were applied to them. Even among those facing disciplinary proceedings, there may have been cases which in their normal course would have ended in exoneration. Therefore, as regards the eligibility for further promotion of the reinstated persons who were compulsorily retired, a general decision applicable to all persons alike is not feasible.

Government, therefore, after considering the question in all its aspects, direct that the promotion and similar benefits of officers who were compulsorily retired under rule 60A Part I Kerala Service Rules, but subsequently

Reinstated, may be examined and decided on merits of each case, taking into consideration the record of service on the eve of compulsory retirement and order accordingly.
