O R D E R

Instances have come to the notice of Government where Officers who own cars travel by their own car between places connected by rail for their transfer journey and claim special mileage which is not admissible under the rules, according to the Government Orders read as 2nd paper above, Ist class railway fare also cannot be claimed as the journeys, were not actually performed by rail in first class. In the circumstances Government consider it necessary to redress the grievances of such Officers to some extent

Therefore Government are pleased to clarify that Grade I Officers who engage special conveyance for their journeys on transfer between places concerned by rail shall be permitted to draw first class railway fare for self and family as provided under rule 67 Part II Kerala Service Rules without the obligation of furnishing a certificate of having traveled by first class.
