## ORDER

In the Government Order read as second paper above orders have been issued based on the Government of India letter read as first paper above that when a State Government employee borne on pensionable establishment is allowed to be absorbed in the Government of India/Autonomous Body the service rendered by him under the Government shall be allowed to be counted towards pension under Government of India autonomous body irrespective of whether the employee was temporary or permanent in government. It is also stipulated therein that the same procedure will be followed in cases of employees of Government of India/Autonomous Body who are permanently absorbed under the State Government/State Autonomous Bodies.

2. The Accountant General in his letter read as third paper above has pointed out that the cases of employees of State autonomous bodies getting absorbed under the Central Government have not been covered in the G.O. read as  $2^{nd}$  paper. Since the orders in the said G.O. have been issued after accepting the Government of India proposal for reckoning the service in such cases also on a reciprocal basis, Government are pleased to order supplying the omission. Accordingly the G.O. read as second paper above is corrected and modified incorporating the words in the second sentence in section of the G.O. after the words "Pensionable establishment", and employees of the State autonomous bodies."
