In the exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of Section 5 of the Kerala Preservation of Trees Act, 1986 (35 pf 1986), the Government of Kerala hereby direct that no three standing in the area specified in the schedule below shall be cut, uprooted, burnt or otherwise destroyed except on the ground that :--
 - (a) the tree constitutes a danger to life or property; or
 - (b) the tree is dead, diseased, or wind fallen.

Explanatory Note

(This does form part of the notification but is intened to indicate its general purport)]

90 Acres of (36.42 Ha) of land involved in O.A 204/77 and O.A. 205/77 of the Forest Tribunal, Kozhikode. (M.F.A. 113/82 and R.P 208/84 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala) are likely to be cleared by felling all the available from therein in the guise of cultivation which will adversely effect soil conservation and moisture retension in the area and cause soil erosion, distruction and loss of timber wealth in the state unless such clearing is prohibited. Government have, therefore, decided to bring the areas specified in the schedule within the purview of section 5 of the Kerala Preservation of Trees Act, 1986. The notification is intended to achieve above subject.

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
