ADVANCES-ADVANCES FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOTOR CONVEYANCES TO GOVERNMENT SERVANTS- ENHANCEMENT OF LIMITS - ORDERED.

ORDER

In view of the increase in the prices of cars due to imposition of additional excise duty, the Government of India have enhanced the maximum monetary limit of the amount of advance admissible to a Government Servant for the Purchase of motor car. The questi-on whether a similar increase in the monetary limit should be given to the Government Servants of this State has been engaging the attention of Government. Having considered the question in all its aspects, Government are pleased to increase the maximum monetary limit of the amount of advance admissible to a Government Servant for the purchase of a motor conveyance. The amount of advance admissible in future for the purchase of a motor car will be Rs,10,000 or twelve months pay/salary or the anticipated price of the car, whichever is the least. For the purchase of a motor cycle or scooter, the amount of advance admissible in future will be 2.500 or 12 months pay/salary or the anticipated price of the vehicle whichever is the least.

- 2. The other existing rules regarding the recovery of these advances etc., will remain as they are.
- 3. The existing rules for the grant of these advances will be modified to the above extent.
