Sub:-GOVERNMENT SERVANTS' CONDUCT RULES 1960-INSISTING IN THE PROVISIONS –INSTRUCTION ISSUED

The attention of all the Heads of Department and office is invited to the provision contained in rules 34 and 35 of the Kerala Government Servant's Conduct Rules 1960. It has come to the notice Government that many of the Heads of Department do not insist on their subordinates submitting the declaration of immovable properties contemplated in the above Rules. The declarations of immovable property under Rules 34 and 35 have to be submitted by all the Government Servants as and when they or any member of their family come into possession of immovable property. Last Grade Government Servants have not been exempted from submitting the declarations under the above Rules. The exemption contemplated for last grade servants in rule 37 is with regard to submission of annual returns only.

The Heads of Departments and office are therefore requested to bring the above provisions in the Rules to the notice of their subordinates and to insist on submission of declarations by all Government servants under their control including their last grade servants in future.
