Government are pleased to order that Government Servants who are appointed as examiners at any examination conducted by the public Service Commission will be treated as on duty for the period they attend the examination work (written, oral or practical) at the same station or a state on other than the place of their normal duty and for the actual number of days required for journey to the place of examination work and back. However if the examination is held in the morning at the same station and the duration of the examination is over at 9 a.m or before, the officer will not be treated as on duty.
