### **NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following further amendment to the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules,1958 namely;-

### **AMENDMENT**

In Part II of the said rules-

In rule 8, after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be added namely:-

"Provided also that this rule shall not apply in the case of a member of a service whose absence from duty in such service is by reason of his appointment to another service, not being Military service, solely on his own application, unless such appointment is made in the exigencies of public service.

Note- An appointment made in pursuance of applications invited, sponsored or recommended by Government or other competent authority shall be deemed to be an appointment made in the exigencies of Public Service for the purpose of this rule.
