In part II of the said Rules, for sub-rule (e) of rule 10, the following shall be substituted, namely;

"(e) In the case of a candidate who is an Ex- service man, the period of his service in the Defence forces and the period of unemployment on discharge up to maximum of five years shall be excluded in computing his age for appointment"

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the amendment but is intended to indicate its general purpose)

In G O (P) No.309/70/PD dated29-8-1970, it was ordered that the period of unemployment up to a maximum of five years should be excluded in the case of Exservicemen for the purpose of reckoning age limits prescribed for direct recruitment to various posts in Government service. It isne3cessray to give statutory validity to the above orders by amending the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules,1958. This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
