## **EXPLANTORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport).

Executive Orders on the decision for Government to resort to special recruitment from Scheduled Castes /Scheduled Tribes to higher categories in all services were issued in G.O (MS) NO . 1008/59/PD dated 25-11-1959 .

Since the issue of these orders , direct recruitment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes have been made in many Department s . Though rule 17 A of the Ke3rala State and Subordinate Services Rules introduced on 23-10-1962 Provides for direct recruitment to any service from among scheduled castes and scheduled tribes not withstanding anything contained in t5he special rule , the rule has no retrospective effect. It has been brought to the notice of Government that such appointments made prior to 23-10-1962 would become irregular if rule 17A is not given retrospective effect . So Government have decided in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission to give retrospective effect to general rule 17A from 25-11-1959 so as to regularize the appointment s made by direct recruitment from Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes till the date of issue of General Rule 17A (i. e .23-10-1962). This notification is intended to achieve the above object .
