ORDER.

According to the G.Os. read above recruitment to ministerial posts has been ordered to be made district-wise subject to the conditions sanctioned therein. One of the conditions prescribed is that the persons recruited district-wise will not be given transfer from one district to another within a period of five years form the date of commencement of continuous service. In the letter read as third paper above the Director of Agriculture has sought for clarification as to whether the above restriction on inter district transfers should be applied to provisional (temporary) employees those services are regularized as per G.O. (P) No. 126/75/PD dated 18.6.1975 and persons appointed under the scheme in G.O. (Ms.) No. 20/70/PD dated 21.1.1970 for giving employment assistance to relatives/dependants of Government servants dying in harness.

Government have examined the question. In order to have uniformity in the matter of inner-district transfer of persons in service and to avoid administrative difficulties Government order that the five year prescribed in the G.O. read as first paper above for the inter- district t5ransfer of districts-wise recruit's will be made applicable to persons regularly absorbed as per G.O. (P) No. 126/75/PD dated 18.6.1975 and G.O.(P) 67/76/PD dated 258.2.1967 and persons appointed as per G.O. (MS)No. 20/70/PD dated 21.1.1970 aga9nst posts which come with the ambit of the G.Os. read above persons regularly absorbed G.O. (P) 126/75/PD dated 186/6/1975 and G.O. (P) 67/76/PD 25/2/1976 and persons appointed as per G.O. (Ms.) 20/70/PD 21.1.1970 against posts which come within the ambit of the G.O. above will not be given transfer form the district to which thy are absorbed appointed to another district within a period of five years the date of regular absorption/appointment.
