ORDER

Several cases of felling of trees in Public lands for various purposes like Widening of Roads, facilitating Sports etc. have come to the notice of Government. There has also been considerable public recentment against such felling of trees.

Government considered the issue in all aspects and found that the tendency for felling trees on public lands under one or other reason has to be discouraged. Hence they order that no person/organization/institution/departmental authority shall without getting the written consent of the Asst. Conservator of Forests, Social Forestry of the District concerned cut, uproot or burn or cause to be cut, uprooted or burnt any tree on public land.
