## CIRCULAR NO. /80

Sub:- Transport of timber from supply coupes without subsidiary passes – Instructions issued.

. . . . . . . . .

As per the standing instructions each load or raft forest produce must be covered by a separate pass in order to have effective check of the transport of the produce from the Reserve Forest. But it is brought to notice by the Additional Chief Conservator of Forests that instances of transporting timber from supply coupes are still being done under cover of main passes in Trivandrum Division and that two or three lorry loads are transported at a time under the cover of the came main pass. This system will lead to all sorts of malpractices and hence it cannot be allowed to continue. The Divisional Forest Officers are directed to follow strictly the standing instructions in the matter and any violation of the above will be viewed very seriously.

If any Divisional Forest Officer is short of stock of bandy man pass books, it is his duty to get supplies from his Conservator of Forests or get it on load from adjoining Divl. Forest Officers short stock of bandy man pass books should not be a reason, in future for using main pass for the transport of load or raft of forest produce from the Reserve Forests.
