Sub:- Transfer and Postings of subordinates-Political and outside pressure regarding.

It has come to my notice that subordinates, particularly Range Officers bring in political or outside influence to bear upon the Chief Conservator of Forests in getting transfers to places or ranges of their choice or for canceling transfer orders issued by superior authorities. As per rule 82 fo the Government Servant's conduct Rules 1960, this is highly irregular and calls for disciplinary action. In a specific case which has come to my notice, necessary charge memo has been issued to the Range officer concerned. The conservators of Forests are also requested to bear this in mind, and see that disciplinary acting is taken against those who act against the provisions in the conduct Rules referred to above. This has become all the more important since this sort of bringing in outside influence ahs become very rampant now-a-days, resulting in frequent transfers, dislocation of work and lack of continuity. This cannot be allowed and has to be our tailed in the interest of efficient functioning of the Department.
