ORDER

In the G.O read above the Government have ordered that permanent Government servants on absorption in a Public Under taking will be eligible for pro-rata Pension and Death cum-retirement Gratuity based on the length of the qualifying service rendered by them in the Government service.

- 2. In the letter second cited, the Accountant General, Kerala has requested clarification as to whether the provisions of Simplified Pension Rules may not be made applicable to the employees absorbed in the Public Undertakings with effect from 14.11.1966 according to which permanency is not a criterion for sanctioning pensionery benefits to an officer.
- 3. The Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order that the condition of permanency in Government service stipulated in para I item (i) of the G.O read above be waived with effect from 14.11.1966 i.e., from the date of coming into effect of the 'Simplified Pension Rule'
