RULES- K.S.R. CONDONATION OF INTERRUPTION-RULING ISSUED

Dated, Trivandrum, 31st August, 1962

O R D E R

Government are pleased to issue the following as a ruling to rule 32 Part III Kerala Service Rules.

R U L I N G

The powers delegated to authorities subordinate to Government under the above rule shall be exercised subject to the following conditions only:-

1. The interruptions should have been caused by reasons beyond the control of the Officers concerned
2. Service proceeding the interruption should not be less than one year and in cases where there are tow or more interruption, the total service, pensionary benefits in respect of which will be lost if the interruptions are not condoned, should not be less than one year.
3. The interruptions should not be more than of five years duration. In cases where there are two or more interruptions the total of the period of all the interruptions that are condoned should not exceed five years.

This will take effect from 31.8.162
