## ORDER

In the G.O read as first paper above, the Conservators of Forests and the Divisional Forest Officers were delegated with powers to conduct auction sale of livestock and confirm such sales, subject to the condition among other things that the Chief Conservator of Forests should be present in cases of auction sale of elephants and ivory. The Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that the insistence on the condition that the sale of elephant and ivory by the Conservators of Forests and the Divisional Forest Officers, is inconvenient. Government have examined the question and are pleased to order that the insistence on the presence of the Chief Conservators of Forests willbe disposed with and that conservators of Forests of concerned will be present at the time of auction sale of elephants and ivory.

The word "Chief" occurring between the words "the" and "Conservator" appearing is column 3 under para 4 against "Conservator Forests" and "Divisional Forest Officers" will be delegated.
