<u>ORDER</u>

In the G.O read as first paper above, the Conservators of Forests and the Divisional Forest Officers were delegated with powers to conduct auction sale of livestock and confirm such sales, subject to the condition among other things, that the Chief Conservator of Forests should be present in cases of auction sale of elephants and ivory. The Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that the insistences on the condition that the Chief Conservator of Forests should be present for auction the sale of elephants and ivory by the Conservators of Forests and the Divisional Forest Officers, is inconvenient. Government have examined the question and are pleased to order that the insistence on the presence of hte Chief Conservator of Forests will be dispensed with and that Conservators of Forests concerned will be present at the time of auction sale of elephants and ivory.

The following amendments are issued to the G.O. (MS) 770/Agri. Dated 29.7.1959

The word "Chief" occuring between the words "the" and "Conservator" appearing in column 3 under para 4 against "Conservator of Forests" and Divisional Forest Officers" will be deleted.
