In part 1 of the said rules, in sub rule © of rule 60,

- (i) After the first sentence, the following sentence shall be inserted, namely:"But they shall not be eligible for promotion to another post during the Period of such extension"
- (ii) The word "But" in the second sentence shall be deleted and for the first letter, namely (i) of the word 'if' the capital letter, namely, 'I' shall be substituted.
- (iii) In the "Explanation" under the rule, after item No (3), the following shall be added as item No. 4, namely:-
  - "(4) Director of Collegiate Education"
