### **NOTIFICATION**

S.R.O.NO.624/79- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the kerala public services act1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 of thereof, the Government of Kerala herby make the following amendment to the kerala state subordinate service rules, 1958, namely;-

#### **AMENDMENT**

- 1. short title and commencement- (1) This rule may be called the Kerala state and subordinate services (Amendment) Rules, 1979.
  - (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from the 14<sup>th</sup> January 1963.
- 2. Amendment of Rule 13- In part II of the kerala state and subordinate services rules 1958 in rule 13 for the existing provision the following provision shall be submitted, namely:-

"provided that in the case of the ministerial staff of the different departments/ officers in the kerala judicial ministerial subordinate service and in the kerala ministerial subordinate service the united tests prescribed in G.O.(P)No 22/63/PD dated the 14<sup>th</sup> January 1963 as subsequently amended or classified shall be applicable until the special Rules for the kerala judicial ministerial subordinate service or the kerala ministerial subordinate service as the case may be come into force.

## **Explanatory note**

(This note is not part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Kerala High Court in a judgment has observed that 14 of the General Rules as amended will not be applicable to the members of the Judicial Ministerial Services as it has not been specially mentioned in the rule. Rule 13 of the General Rules has therefore to be amended with retrospective effect so that the rule may be applicable to the members of the judicial Ministerial Service till the special Rules for the Kerala Judicial Ministerial subordinate services came into force. The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
