**Abstract**

Forests - supply of bamboos to Private parties for construction of Poultry Houses - orders issued.

**ORDER**

With a view to giving encouragement to persons taking up poultry production under the deep litter system the Director of Animal Husbandry has recommended to Government that bamboos may be arranged to be supplied to them at seignior age value for construction of Poultry houses.

Government have examined the matter in consultation with the Chief Conservator of Forests. Since the deep litter system of poultry development is of special importance in the context of Agricultural Development and Food production Programs, Government consider that those who came forward to take up poultry production deserve encouragement until the poultry industry is properly established. They are therefore pleased to sanction the proposal of the Director of Animal Husbandry on the following conditions:-

1. Same applicant should not be given bamboos for the purpose at less than 5 years interval. However, he may be granted bamboos for constructing new houses to expand the business.
2. Supply should normally be at the rate of one bamboo per layer raised.
3. Applications for bamboos will be certified and recommended by Assistant Directors of Poultry, Project Officers of Intensive Poultry Development Blocks or District Veterinary Officers of the respective areas.

The Divl. Forest Officers concerned will allot the bamboos according to availability from convenient places.

The applicants should cut and remove the bamboos as per the existing rules at their expense.

The Divl. Forest Officer will obtain necessary utilization certificate from the officers who recommend the requirements in each case.

As the bamboos are generally of 20' length it may be possible for the Director of Animal Husbandry to work out the number of bamboos required for constructing one poultry house. He will fix up the number and intimate the Chief Conservator of Forests accordingly.
