Sub: Sale of Rubber Coupes – Procedures for extension of time – prescribed.

ORDER NO G3.7162/61

The Rubber Coupes sold out from the various Divisions of the Forest Department

have been under working for the last two months. The time prescribed in the agreement

is due to expire on 31-3-1961. Representations have been received from practically

almost all the coupe holders that due to several causes beyond their control, i.e., credit

difficulties, non-availability of lorries and labor, they have not been also to remove large

quantities of timber and firewood collected, and in some cases, felling of a small

percentage of the area is also pending completion.

A recommendation has been made to the Government for granting extensions.

Orders on this are pending scrutiny in the Finance Department. As this is likely to take

some more time, and it is felt that it will be practically impossible to stop the work and

for the Forest Department or any other Department to assume charge of the area wherein

large quantities of timber and firewood are still pending removal, it was decided in

consultation with the Agriculture Secretary, that pending final orders of Government the

Collection and transport from Rubber coupes may be permitted to be continued till 30th

April 1961 subject to the coupe contractors filing a statement to the effect that they are

agreeable to pay the penalties prescribed in the agreement executed by them.
