ORDER

Government have been considering the inclusion of the definition of the terms supply cum sale contract in the Forest Code. The Chief Conservator of Forests has forwarded a draft proposal for the purpose.

Government examined the proposal and are pleased to order that the following definition will be included as serial No.37 (b) in para 2.1.1. of Kerala Forest Code Vol. I and the present item “Schedule contract” will be renumbered as 37 (a)

37 (b) Supply-cum-sale contract, Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in my provision of the Kerala Forest Code or the Forms prescribed there under or any other document pertaining to Forest Transactions, Supply-cum-sale means, sale of tree growth with the obligation on the part of the purchase contractor, to work down all teak, Rosewood or any other species specified in the sale notice (not intended for sale) to the Depot at the rate fixed in advance on the basis of forest schedule of rates.
