CIRCULAR NO.1/81

It has come to the notice of the Conservator of Forests that petitions are being received from the bidders after the auction sale of task poles stating that poles are not available in the plantation, the poles are burnt, stolen or are not lotted properly etc. To avoid such defects and complains all Divisional Forest Officers are directed that the auction sale of poles should be conducted at the dumping site itself and not in Range Offices away from the Plantation. In case it is felt by the Divisional Forest Officers that it is difficult to approach the dumping sites at the time of auction or for transport outside he may select a suitable known Central Place including Range Offices. This will enable the Divisional Forest Officer/Auctioning Officers to know the conditions of poles whether they are stacked and lotted properly, etc.
