Notification

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 39 and 40 of the Kerala Forest Act, 1961 (4 of 1962) read with subsection (3) of section 85 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the rules to regulate the transit of timber in the Malabar district referred to in sub-section (20 of section 5 of the states Reorganization Act, 1956, published under G.O.MS. No. 2762, Agriculture, dated the 26th November, 1955. as subsequently amended, names-

amendment.

In the said rules, in rule 3, for the existing sub rule (via.) the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"(vi) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rules (1) to (v) no permit shall be required for the removal of timber of the following species namely:-

Jack, cashewnut (Anacardium accidentale), Casuarina, Puvaresu, Mango, Tamarind, Nattupunna, Anjill, Vaha species, Puvan, Konna, Tanni, illuppa, kodumpuli, Uthi, mangosa Rubber (Heven Braziliensis) Ficus Species and Brithrine Indica and Erithrina Iythoseperma (Murukku)."
